

Americans Support Infrastructure Investment More Than Any Other National Issue






This Support Has Remained Consistent Year Over Year

Building a wall on the Mexican border	25%	30%	35%	+5%




Americans Support Water Infrastructure Investment Specifically





This Support Has Also Remained Consistent Year Over Year






Voters Support Action NOW

We should largely leave our water infrastructure in place, and simply fix problems and breakdowns as they occur






